Canine Activity Selection Chart

Before planning your enrichment program, use the MAKE A PLAN process on the shelterhealthprowebsite to assess your dog for safety, skills, and personality.

Enrichment is:

- · An ongoing process, not a single object or event
- Only enriching if the animal chooses to interact with it or is affected positively by it
- Specific to the dog based on its assessment (See Animal Assessment)

A daily enrichment schedule includes all opportunities for enriching the animal's life. It incorporates a combination of sensory, physical, environmental, cognitive and social activities. You can also find a wide variety of options in Enrichment for Dogs and Puppies.

Activity	Frequency	Type of Stimulation	Especially Good For:	Personnel Required	Notes
Classical music	Daily, but not continuously throughout the day	Auditory	All dogs	Staff or volunteer to change the CDs	Bird song CDs are also good; check out used CD stores for inexpensive choices; vary when music is played and choose music that doesn't increase vocal behaviour
A different scent – indoor or outdoor kennel	Daily	Olfactory	Scent hounds, but almost all dogs will engage with olfactory stimulation	Staff or volunteers to distribute	Can be introduced during daily cleaning; use diluted cooking extracts (vanilla, almond, etc), sweet spices; buy in bulk from warehouse stores
